Arkansas Union:

- ? Chartwells is beginning an aggressive campaign to recruit student associates for the spring. The kick-off was a job fair that was held on Friday, Jan. 6. In the near term, Chartwells is planning to activate other events and media to further grow student hires.

Last spring student associates numbered 42 and accounted for approximately 9,600 working hours. This past Fall, with active recruiting, student associates grew to 108 with nearly 24,000 working hours. Chartwells drove the increase in several ways: education at orientation and other campus events, with new perks like payment of parking passes and safety shoes, and awareness of higher starting wage and scheduling flexibility. New student associates are also offered training and a view into long term career opportunities with Chartwells / Compass Group.

In addition to the growth in student hires, we recognized a deepening in the diversity of these associates and achieved a truer representation of the overall student population. Student associates have been invaluable in growing the day-to-day connection with student customers and in increasing awareness of social media channels.
