With the beginning of Leadership Walton's third year, students have completed over 365 community service projects and attended over 700 academic lectures. 258 students were in the program as of summer 2009; and another group of approximately 200 students began the program this fall.

Leadership Walton Program Highlights

Sustainability Project Saves Local Residents Over \$17,500

In March of 2009, Leadership Walton students, in conjunction with SIFE and Leadership Fayetteville participants, collected over 400 CFL light bulbs. On April 17, a group of Leadership Walton and SIFE students used donated bulbs to replace energy inefficient lights at Fayetteville Housing Authority properties. These bulbs are expected to save utility users over \$17,500 and prevent over 100,000 pounds of harmful CO2!

Leadership Walton Students Receive Summer Scholarships

This summer, eight Leadership Walton students received the 2009 Arkansas Cooperative Education Program in Business Scholarship. These students worked in Arkansas at a job or internship that pertained to their major. The scholarship promotes the importance of students gaining relevant business experience in the workplace.

Center for Retailing Excellence Mentor Program

In the fall of 2008, 13 Leadership Walton students were selected to participate in the new Center for Retailing Excellence Mentor Program. Students will receive an extensive, two-year mentor experience from companies including Nestle Purina, Procter & Gamble, Sam's Club and Lowe's. Another nine students were selected to begin the mentor program in the fall of 2009.
