- Walk-in Flu Clinic ends finals week – Don't let the flu ruin winter break. Get your flu vaccine before the walk-in clinic ends. Getting your annual flu shot is the best way to protect against contracting the flu. The Allergy, Immunization and Travel Clinic Walk-in Flu Vaccine clinic is from 3-5 p.m. every Monday through Friday. Students, Faculty and Staff can walk-in, or call 479-575-7223 to schedule an appointment. Remember to bring your insurance card.
- Health Center offers walk-in STI testing clinic as reported STIs continue to be at all-time high in US – Sexually transmitted infections (STIs) are at an all-time high. To help battle the alarming and rising trends of STIs, Pat Walker Health Center offers the "Get Yourself Tested" (GYT) walk-in testing clinic for chlamydia & gonorrhea — the two most common STIs among college students. The clinic is available from 4:30 to 6:30 p.m. every Tuesday, Wednesday and Thursday, and from 10 a.m. to 2 p.m. every Saturday the health center is open.

The GYT Clinic offers easy and convenient urine testing for patients experiencing no symptoms, and can be billed to insurance or self-pay. Patients can expect their results within a few business days.
