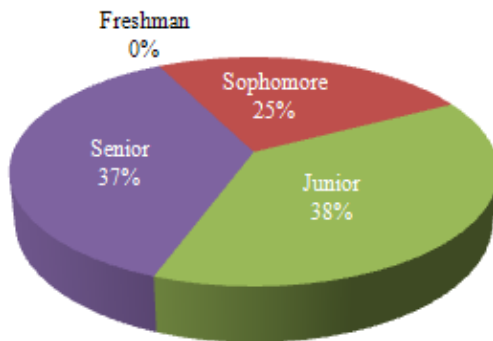

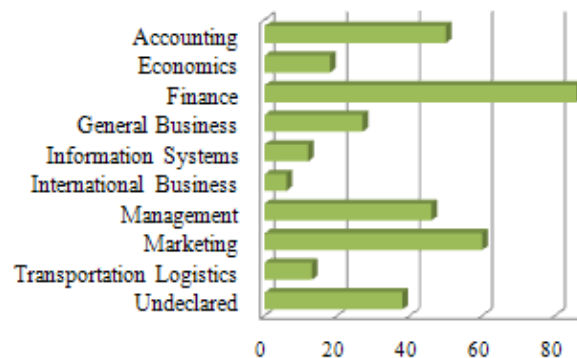


There are currently 342 students participating in Leadership Walton. Another 200 students, including approximately 150 freshmen, are expected to begin the program in the fall of 2010.

## Leadership Walton Highlights

### Leadership Experience

Program participants are required to complete 41 components, including community service activities. In the program's three year history, Leadership Walton students have completed over 685 community service projects.

### Leadership Walton Adopts Skull Creek Trail

In March of 2010, Leadership Walton students, along with staff members of the Sam M. Walton College of Business Career Center, picked up litter along Skull Creek Trail in Fayetteville. Leadership Walton will continue to maintain the trail and host cleanup days at least three times per year.

In the spring of 2010, Leadership Walton participants collected over 500 non-perishable food items to benefit the Northwest Arkansas Food Bank.



## Northwest Arkansas Children's House Supply Drive

Throughout the month of November 2009, Leadership Walton participants collected donations for the Northwest Arkansas Children's House, which provides a safe environment for children to overcome the devastating effects of abuse and neglect. Over 630 items were collected, including school supplies, plastic storage containers, cake mixes and frosting. Donations were delivered at the end of the fall 2009 semester.
