Remember to complete the Tobacco Pledge in webBASIS as part of your Health Benefits this month. If you do not complete that pledge, you may be charged \$50 a month in addition to your health insurance.

Information from Staff Senate:

If you, the employee carrying the University's medical insurance, do not complete the Tobacco Pledge and Notice, you will be charged the \$50 surcharges starting January 2019.

To avoid the \$50 surcharge, there are two options:

**Not a tobacco user** (Non-users must complete the pledge and agree to continue to remain tobacco-free) **or**

**A tobacco user who agrees to participate in a cessation program** (Tobacco users will commit to enroll in and complete a recognized tobacco cessation program in 2019).

### **CENTER FOR COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT:**

SNAP Day will be November 27<sup>th</sup> at the Wellness Center on Garland – the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program or SNAP (formerly food stamps) is a federal safety net program providing low-income Americans with the food they need to feed themselves and their families. The Center for Community Engagement and the Jane B. Gearhart Full Circle Pantry will host two application assistance trainings and a SNAP application clinic with the Arkansas Hunger Relief Alliance. Trainings are tentatively set for 10 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. – please watch the VCSA listserv for more information and sign-up links.

The Jane B. Gearhart Full Circle Food Pantry has opened sign-ups for holiday meal baskets. These baskets will include a ham or turkey as well as sides for a holiday meal and will be distributed in December before students leave for winter break.
