- III. Presentation of Housing Resolution – Henry Rowe; Henry presented a resolution to the Housing Department.

 2. Sustainability Commission
 - a. BYOB Program (Bring Your Own Water Bottle) - The Commission had a construction made of water bottles and gave out over 3,000 water bottles.
