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A. Provost, Ashok Saxena

- Budget expect to maintain our budget. Will know later in the month. Overall, some new revenues are expected which will go back into the Academic side of campus. Already planning for faculty needs for the fall.
- Working on a plan to manage the number of incoming Freshmen in an organized fashion. Currently, do not have flexibility to handle the numbers as one would like. Hope to manage numbers better in the next recruiting season. Regardless, diversity, quality and numbers are good. Still need to work on the balance of undergraduates to graduates.
- Have appointed a couple of Deans Matt Waller, WCOB for five years; Mike Miller, COEHP for two years. Still have another Dean's position in Bumpers College. Actively exploring options for this. Hope to have a final word in the next week to 10 days.
- Additional changes; student services position upgraded to Vice Chancellor for Student Success. Charles Robinson will be in this role and will leave the Diversity position he now holds which will change to the Vice Provost of Diversity and Inclusion. In the process of finalizing all of this. An interim will be selected to replace Robinson with a search this fall to fill the position permanently.
- OEOC office will be reworked and will report to the Provost. Implementation will take a few more weeks.
